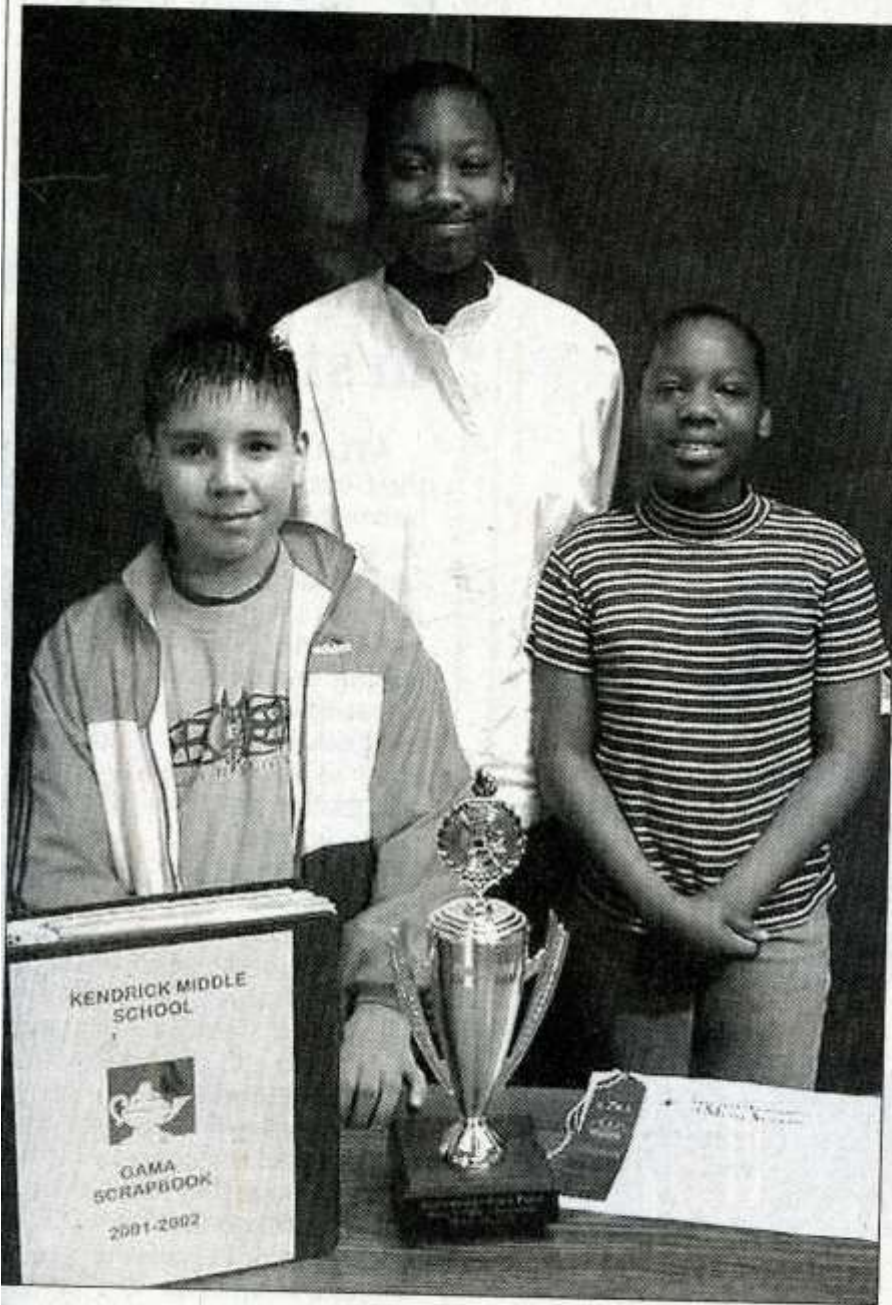


Kendrick Middle takes first place awards
